As a student of the International Baccalaureate Programme of DeLand High School, I understand the following program components listed below and agree to adhere to them:

- I will follow all rules of DeLand High School and Volusia County Schools.

I will take appropriate action in the following ways to initiate investigation of a perceived violation: confront my peer, tell my teacher and/or inform the IB coordinator so we can all guard against malpractice within the program.**
